Time to Shine title: *On Trial: Prosecution and Defence in Criminal Law*

Time to Shine description: In order to succeed as a lawyer, it is vital that students master the art of presenting their cases. Throughout the course, students will participate in an assignment in which they will develop a case for the defence, or prosecution, in a mock legal trial. This project will culminate in a full simulation of a legal trial, including judges, lawyers, barristers, prosecutors and defendants which takes place in a real-life courtroom at the old court in Oxford.

- A guide to legal language and legal argumentation.
- A guest speech from a working barrister, who will guide the students through the processes in legal trials in the UK.
- Take part in our exciting *On Trial* Time to Shine project, in which you and your classmates will simulate a trial in a real court room.
- Through fun and engaging lesson activities, develop and apply your 21st century skills, such as critical thinking, communication skills, collaborative skills, and original thinking.
